-  **Registered IT Technician (RITTech)**  
Recognises the talents of professionals who responsible or involved in managing the design, build and maintenance of our digital world, and demonstrates your competence and skills.
  
-  **Chartered IT Professional (CITP)**  
Demonstrates the highest standard of current competence to employers and the value you bring as a highly-skilled IT practitioner.
  
-  **Chartered Engineer (CEng)**  
Demonstrates your innovation, creativity and technical accountability in engineering technology solutions.
  
-  **Incorporated Engineers (IEng)**  
Maintain and manage applications of current and developing technology, and may undertake engineering design, development, manufacture, construction and operation.

For further advice on or to apply for any of the above standards at no cost to you, speak to your BCS coordinator.

Holding a standard means you have a responsibility to continually maintain and develop your competence, and you will be required to evidence this when you revalidate. As a BCS member, you'll have access to CPD tools and resources to easily plan and document CPD activities and keep track of your progress.
